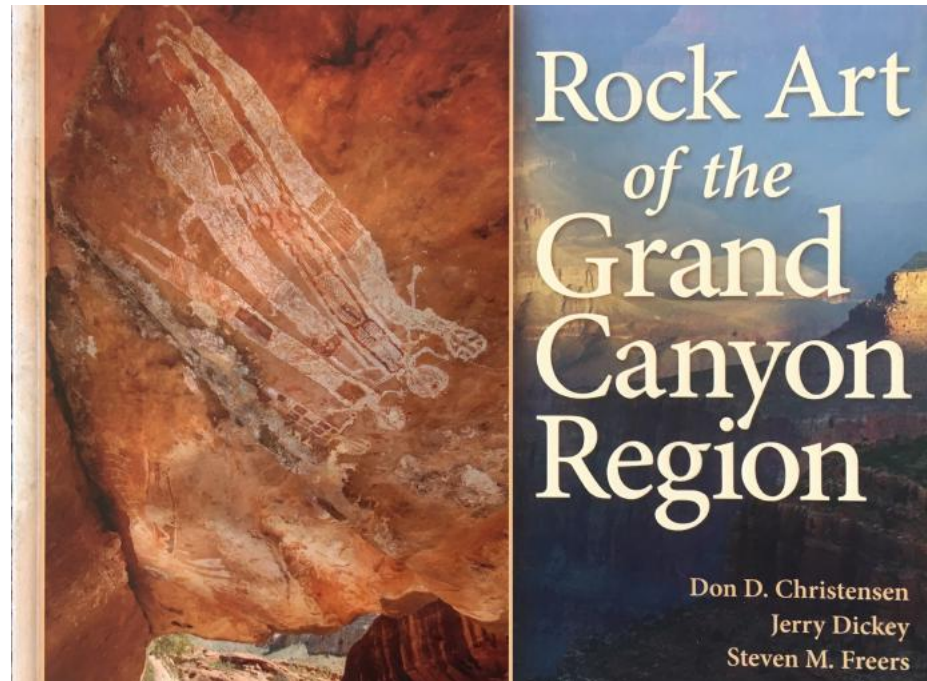




Highlights of the Esplanade Style

- There are some similarities to Barrier Canyon Style and Pecos Style images. These two styles are also considered to be Late Archaic.





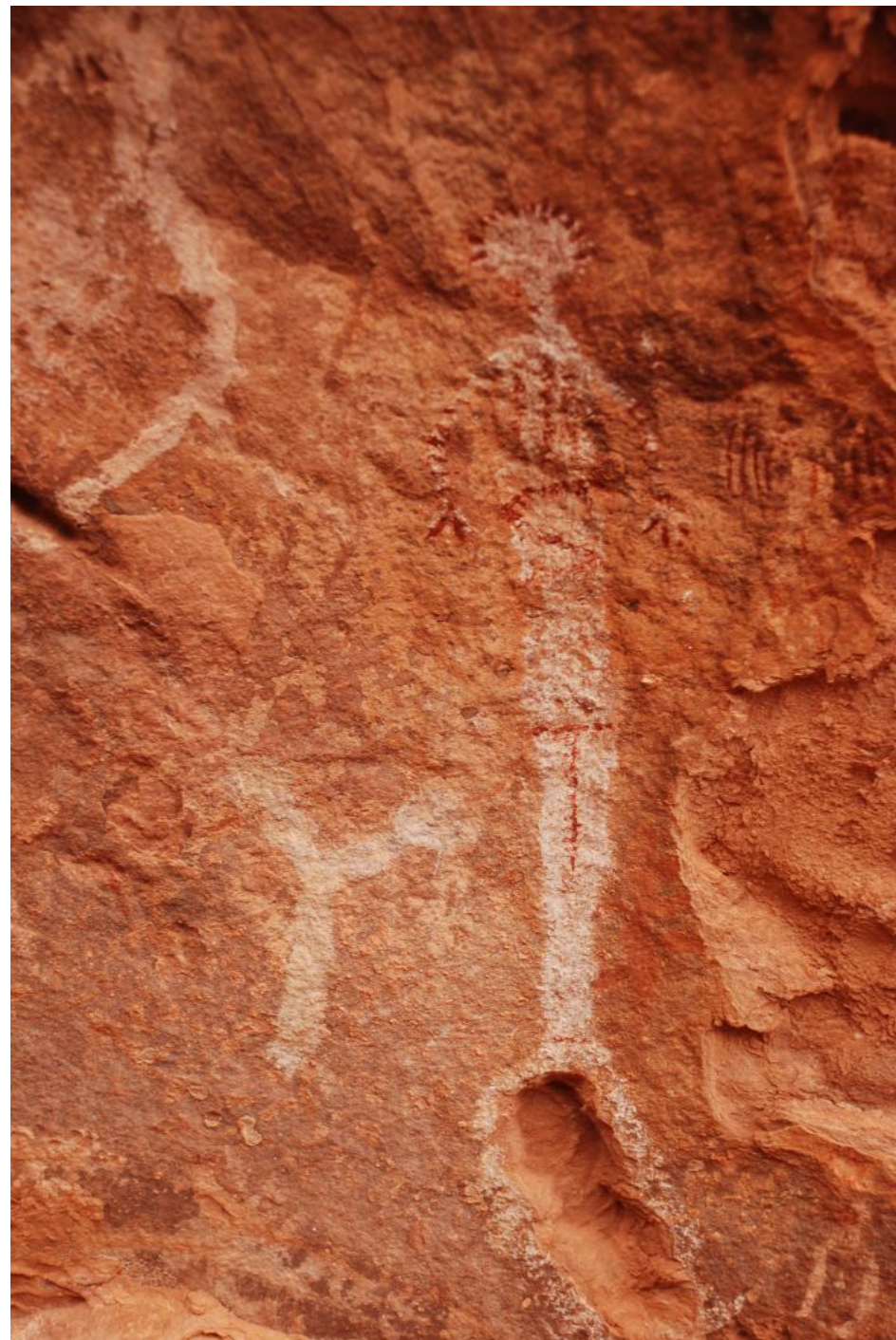
